Overview

- Vermont's allocation of the Environmental Mitigation Trust is \$18.7 million.
- Agency of Natural Resources is Vermont's designated lead agency.
- Goal reduce NOx emissions.
- Vermont is prioritizing electrification.


- 1. Class 8 Local Freight Trucks

Light-Duty EVSE

- The full 15% of Vermont's funding has been allocated to EVSE.
- ACCD is implementing the EVSE Grant Program.
- Prioritizing workplaces, destinations, downtowns, multi-unit dwellings, and highway corridors.



Light-Duty EVSE Funds Awarded

- Round 1 February 2019, \$400,000 awarded.
- Included nine projects at a mix of downtowns, park and rides, workplaces, colleges and highway corridors.
- Level 2 8 projects, 1 DCFC project.



Light-Duty EVSE Funds Awarded

- Round 2 July 2019, \$650,000 awarded.
- Included 21 projects at a mix of downtowns, park and rides, workplaces, colleges and highway corridors.
- Level 2 18 projects, DCFC 3 projects.
- Round 3 will focus on expanding Vermont's DCFC network along highway corridors.



Electric School & Transit Bus Pilot

- VEIC is administering the program of behalf of DEC.
- Test and evaluate the viability of electric buses in Vermont as replacements for diesel-powered buses.
- Four school buses and two transit buses.
- RFP seeking two schools and a transit agency has been issued, responses are due Oct. 2.



What's Next?

- Anticipating releasing an open solicitation for all eligible mitigation actions under the VW Environmental Mitigation Trust, looking for electrification proposals.
- EVSE Grant Program Round 3 DCFC Network Expansion.
